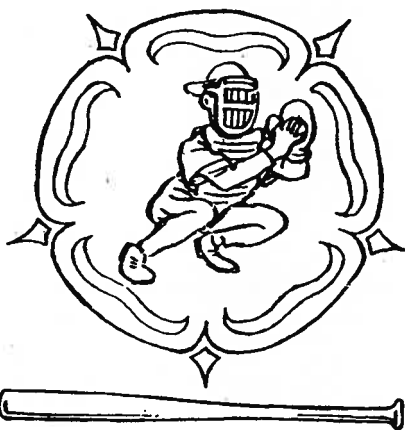

A BRIEF EXPLANATION OF BASEBALL

A Game consists of nine innings for each team. An innings terminates when three men of the batting side are out. A Strike is a ball that passes over the home plate between the batter's knees and shoulder. A Ball is called when a pitchers ball is outside the former described area. After Three Strikes the batter is Out. But if the pitcher sends four balls the batter Walks to first base. A Fair Hit is one that settles or flies over fair ground i.e. inside the foul lines. Outside this area is a Foul Ball. A batter becomes a base runner when a Fair Hit is made or when given a Walk. A base runner is Out if the ball is held on First Base before he reaches it. At 2nd, 3rd and home plate the runner must be touched with the ball held by the fielder Except when play is Forced. The commentator will explain the game as it progresses. You will find our game easy to follow, and we are sure you will enjoy Baseball. The whole object of the game is to make a complete circuit of the bases before three men are Out. Pitching distance = 60 ft. 6 ins. Between bases 90 ft.
