A BRIEF EXPLANATION OF BASEBALL

A GAME consists of nine innings for each team. An innings terminates when three men of the batting side are out. A strike is a ball that passes over the home plate between the batters! knees and shoulders. A ball is called when a pitchers ball is outside the former described area. After three strikes the batter is OUT. But, if the pitcher sends four balls, the batter walks to first base A Fair Hit is one that settles or flies over fair ground i.e., insid the foul-lines. Outside this area is a Foul Ball. A batter become a base runner when a Fair Hit is made, or, when given a Walk.

A base runner is <u>Out</u> if the ball is held on <u>First Base</u>, before he reaches it. At 2nd, 3rd and home plate, the runner must be touched with the ball held by the fielder, <u>except</u> when play is <u>Forced</u>. The Commentator will explain the game as it progresses. You will find the game easy to follow and we are sure you will enjoy <u>Baseball</u>

The whole object of the game is to make a complete circuit of the bases before three men are <u>OUT</u>.

Pitching distance = 60 ft. 6 ins.

Between Bases = 90 ft.
