In future issues we shall run a quiz on Baseball problems. This should create interest and trust will raise many arguments and discussions in the Clubroom. The following issue will contain the answers.

1. When two teams continually wrangle over decisions is there any set time for them to stop? May the game be called off or a forfeit take place?
2. Eight players take the field for their half of an inning, The ball is batted and caught. At that moment the captain of the home team notes that but eight men are on the field. What should the Umpire do on an appeal?
3. A legally pitched ball passes over Home Plate above the shoulders of the batter who is stooping. Had he been standing erect the ball would have been below the shoulders to have been called a strike. What should this be called?
4. Batter makes a two base hit and reaches  $\frac{1}{2}$  second base safely. Ball was returned to the pitcher, who passed it to the shortstop. Pitcher walked back to his position and without putting his foot on the plate placed both hands in front of him in an attitude as if he had the ball. Catcher gave the signal, and then the shortstop touched the runner as he walked off second. Umpire called runner out because the pitcher was not on the plate. Would'nt it be a balk?
5. There are runners on first and third bases. In attempting to catch the runner on first rapping, the pitcher makes a balk. Is the runner on third entitled to score?
6. Runner on first base, one out, and count three and two on the batter. On the wind-up for the next pitch the runner started for second base and reached the base as the catcher dropped a missed strike. Batter reached first base on a bad error by the catcher. Umpire ruled both runners safe, claiming that the runner from first had stolen second on the pitch and therefore was no longer occupied. Team on the field protested, contending that the batter was out automatically. Which is correct?
7. Batter makes third strike and catcher misses ball. Batter starts to run and deciding it is useless stops out of line for a foot or two. Catcher
