Monarchs (Wokingham)

Formed in late 1948 the Monarchs have had a short but varied career. The club is composed entirely of home-spun talent and at no time during the two seasons of its existence have the Monarchs boasted any Canadian or American players.

Last season the club suffered the humiliation of 26 consecutive defeats and only one win, but this year the boys have found their feet and to

date have won 13 of the 23 played.

All the players started from scratch when the club was formed so it would be difficult to name any stars, the only new member being Al Robinson, an Army man ex-Merseyside Wildcats.

ESSEX CUBS

Though the Essex Baseball Club had two teams when formed in 1937 it did not re-start its second-string till last season. After an average season in 1949 the Cubs have achieved great success in 1950 and have won the Pitsea Cup in addition to their League championship. They contest their League Intermediate Knock-out Cup Final with Aveley Cubs next Sunday.
