

Overview

The inaugural class of inductees into the British Baseball Hall of Fame was announced on 13 October 2009, and the induction of further classes takes place annually. The Board of Electors comprises individuals who have researched the history of British baseball, with an additional member being a representative from the board of the British Baseball Federation. Electors put forward nominations for each class and also vote on whether each candidate should be inducted or not. Nominations are also put forward by Regional Experts, who have been appointed to assist the British Baseball of Hall of Fame with biographical details.

The threshold for induction into the inaugural class was a 75% minimum.
