

# 2010 British Baseball Photography Competition

## Competition rules and procedures

1. The 2010 British Baseball Photography Competition is accepting entries between January 2010 and September 2010, inclusive.
2. Photos must be from 2010 and capture some aspect of British baseball. They do not necessarily have to feature game action. For instance, a photo capturing the reaction of a spectator at a game would be a perfectly valid entry.
3. Each photographer can submit up to 20 images over the course of the competition.
4. To be eligible, each submitted photo must be accompanied by a description including a one-sentence caption, as well as the names of any people featured, their team or teams if applicable, and the date on which and location at which the photo was taken.
5. The judges will assess both the photo's overall quality and its strength in helping to chronicle British baseball.
6. The best entries - as assessed by a panel comprising a Project Cobb representative and two BaseballSoftballUK representatives - will be published on the British Baseball Federation website and the Project Cobb website. Depending on the number of entries, the best photos will be featured either in online galleries posted at regular intervals during the course of the season (on a monthly basis, for instance) or in a single online gallery posted after the end of the competition.
7. After the competition closes, the panel will decide upon one overall winner from among the best entries. This overall winner will receive a Jessops gift card with £100 credit (or an equivalent prize if this is not available at the time), donated by BaseballSoftballUK.
8. The competition is limited to photos that do not picture any individuals under the age of 18 years. By submitting a photo, the photographer is confirming that he or she has verified that any individuals featured in the image are aged 18 years or over.
9. Submitting a photo constitutes an agreement to the use of that photo - with a photographer's name credit - in BaseballSoftballUK press materials and corporate materials, as well as on the British Baseball Federation's website.
10. Entries will not be accepted from judges or from BaseballSoftballUK employees.
